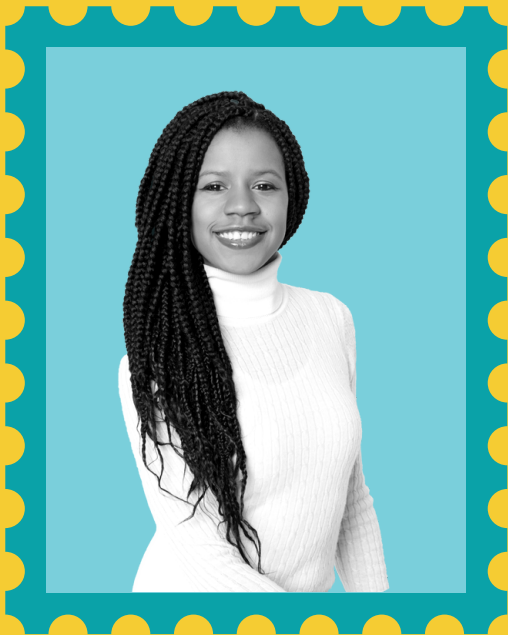

What is League of Innovators?

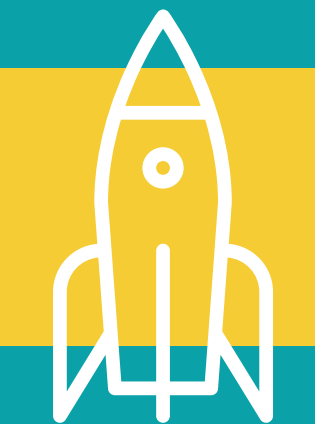

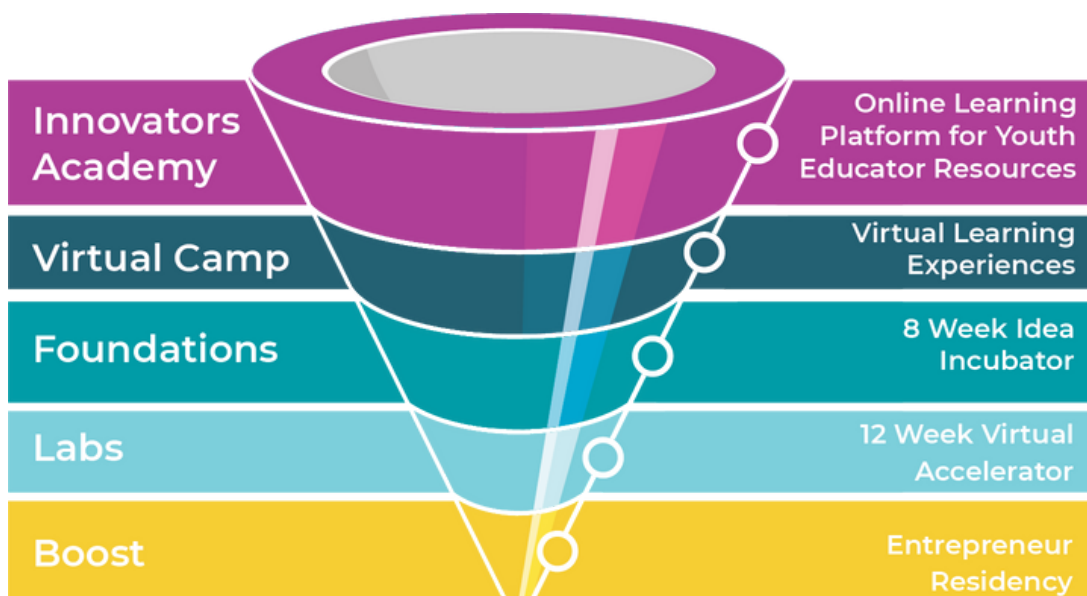


The LOI Difference



In addition to supporting the personal development of young people, our programming and education contributes to tangible economic success. League of Innovators helps bolster Canada as a hub for innovation and growth with our unique approach:

1. Alternative entrepreneurial curriculum created specifically for youth ages 15–30.
2. Connection to a national network—in person and online.
3. Free, equitable access regardless of gender, race, ethnicity, location or socioeconomic situation.
4. Prioritizing drive, curiosity and passion over academic standing or institutional affiliation.



A Year in Programs

In 2022, LOI doubled down on providing founders with high-touch, high-quality mentorship and resources to support their entrepreneurial endeavors, no matter the stage of their business, whether it be ideation or scale up.

DISCOVERY

The support LOI provides in the earliest stages of entrepreneurship is critical, as it helps founders navigate the challenges and uncertainties that come with starting a new venture. Access to LOI's discovery programming helps founders overcome obstacles, build confidence, and increase their chances of success. In 2022 we welcomed **102** founders into our camp and **59** participants in our challenge.

ENTREPRENEURSHIP SUMMER CAMP

A virtual camp that leads budding entrepreneurs through the process of finding their personal why, identifying and understanding problems they want to solve, building and validating solutions, and sharing their ideas.

IMPACT INNOVATION CHALLENGE

Helps young changemakers validate their unique ideas, gain access to a national network of resources and mentors, and gives them the confidence to work on tangible solutions to personal, economic and social issues.

ACCELERATION

Our acceleration programs are designed to support founders in every aspect of accelerating their business, from operationalization, to launch and go-to-market, to scale-up. In 2022 we welcomed **227** startups into our 2022 cohorts.

FOUNDATIONS

An immersive 6-week program delivered online for any young person wanting to test their impact idea, startup, or non-profit.

LABS

A 12-week accelerator focused on supporting youth entrepreneurs ready to launch and grow their startups.

BOOST

A 12-month residency for high-growth youth-led startups across Canada, led by founders under the age of 30.

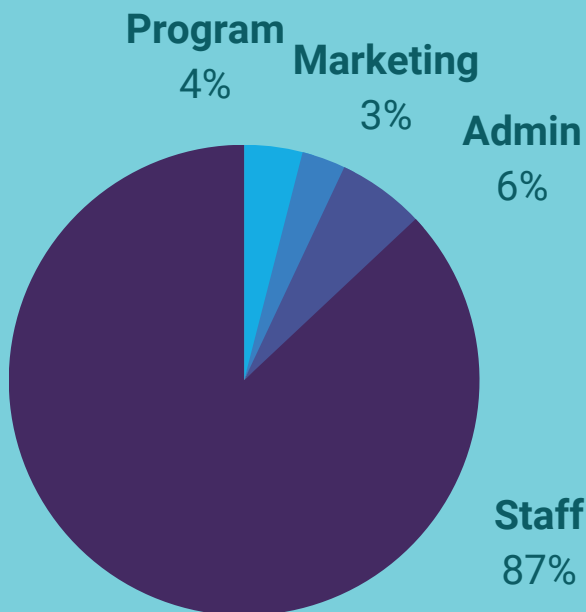
Financial Highlights

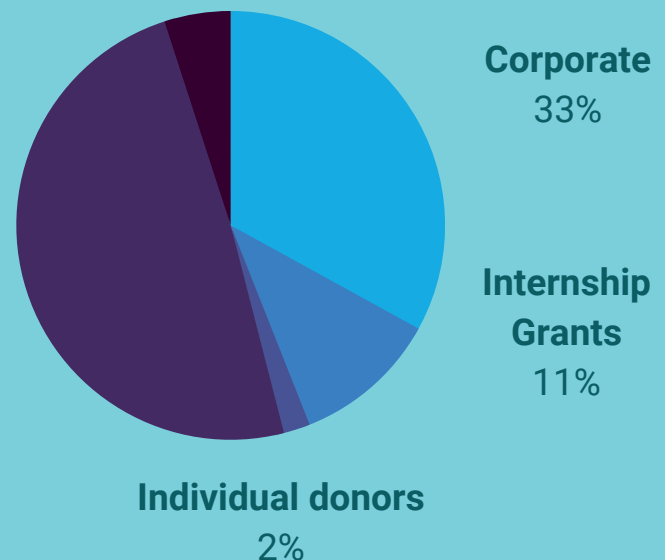
Investment in Impact
